

# Innovation Campus to open

BROOKINGS (AP) – The first building on the Innovation Campus at South Dakota State University will open this week and welcome several tenants.

The Innovation Campus is a 125-acre research park that will mix established companies with startup companies.

Executive Director Teresa McKnight says a second building is planned to open in 12 to 18 months.
